We had a great opportunity this month to travel about four hours away to the next province over to preach in a town of 7,000 people with no gospel witness. It is a Catholic farming town with only one Catholic Church and no other Church of any kind. Last

October we were blessed to meet one of the families from this town at an Independent Baptist Church where the mother and son were


baptized. Her husband was not yet ready to make a spiritual decision, but was very friendly and open to discussion. This family invited the pastor to bring a group to their town to see what doors the Lord might open to begin a new church there. He organized a trip to their town and invited me and another Baptist pastor to come and preach. A community center was rented for the weekend and we preached three messages on Saturday night and three more messages on Sunday. We also had a great picnic at one of the sports clubs in town and talked about the Bible, Christ and





life late into the night until early in the morning. Pray for this family as well as the two other families that we met while there. Like Cornelius in the Bible, they gathered all of their family in the town to hear the message. After returning home, we started a social media private group for the people of this town and everyone that went on the trip. Immediately this group blew up with activity. My goal is to continue the discipleship process no matter the distance. Each day we are sharing back and forth through the group to encourage one another. We have already begun planning another trip back there at the beginning of

April. Please pray that the Lord continues to stir hearts!



My family and I were invited last weekend to go tent camping with about 3 or 4 other families. The purpose of the trip was to share the gospel with several lost people that were there. I enjoyed the opportunity to preach one of the evenings. It was also great getting to hear my kids speaking a lot of Spanish with the other kids. I am very proud of the work that all of my family has been putting
