each week and it pains our heart to think about the ones that would be hearing the message that are currently not able to.

#### A Trip to See a Waterfall

Since the ones we've been working with in Malvinas Argentinas decided they would like to have Sunday evening service. We knew we wouldn't be able to fit in any kind of a vacation once summer ended and all the school year activities started back up. With all that in mind we decided to go on a shorter trip to take the kids to see the waterfall at La Cumbrecita a town a couple of hours from where we live.

#### Joanna's 6th Birthday

We timed our outing to visit La Cumbrecita around Joanna's birthday. Once we arrived back home she opened presents and ate birthday cake. One of her presents was a candle making kit. She enjoyed making her own birthday candles. Since we made the candles with a longer wick she was able to use them for the cake we took to Malvinas also to celebrate with our friends there.

#### Elisabeth's First Professional Haircut

Elisabeth has super thick curly hair. She prefers to take care of her hair herself. She doesn't like for me to comb it and it was starting to get too long for her to take care of it herself. She was getting some crazy rats nests in her hair. So I told her she was going to need a haircut. She has a very sensitive head and combing her hair brings her to tears. I took her to a beauty salon and they started washing and combing the matted tangles out of her hair. There was one other new experience for us both. A hairstylist came in wearing a dress, long hair, and a lot of makeup. However something seemed off with "her". Which my suspicions were confirmed as soon as "she" started speaking with a very masculine voice. I think he was afraid to cut my hair. After sweeping the floor he turned his focus on helping the other stylists with Elisabeth's hair. When Elisabeth started to cry I told them to stop trying to comb it out and just cut the tangles. I had to give this stylist credit though he saved her hair. Elisabeth was pretty upset over the combing but was better during the haircut part. I wasn't sure if she realized anything different about the hairstylist until she asked me while we were waiting to pay, "Mom, was that person that cut my hair a guy or a girl?" I told her I would explain it later once we left. So I took her out for ice cream and had a good talk about the hairstylist.

#### **Problems in Malvinas Argentinas**

Things were going so well and we were excited to see more interest in our Bible Studies but then a spark lit the fuse. One of the Wednesdays we arrived for the Bible Study and the family that we first started meeting with had just spent a good part of their day filling their front yard with rocks. The adults were tired and the little boy was very distracting during the service as we kept having to stop him from pouring rocks on his head or on the plants around the yard. This upset some of the men who were impatient with the boy. They tried locking the gate which upset the wife of the house. Things could have been better if they would have been patient and saved their discussions for the following service but instead they started discussing it as soon as we left. All the problems in their marriage came out from that one spark.

#### A Four Hour Visit

I received an unhappy message from the wife over her husband and while I couldn't solve all their problems I offered to come visit her that Friday. I spent half a day with her on Friday. We discussed the problem with distractions and some possible changes we could make to solve some of it. We also planned on possibly having a special Ladies' Bible Study once a month with the young mother that has been learning and growing. We also discussed having a divided time on Wednesdays where the men and women could have a divided class and prayer time for at least a few minutes. When I left I thought we had solved things. I told her that Scott would talk to the men on Sunday and we would discuss the other changes for the next service. Sadly what felt like a fruitful visit turned completely upside down with just a few angry messages. Then she canceled all services until further notice without discussion. That put us in an awkward situation as we cannot have meetings in their home without their permission.

#### Visiting the Park in Malvinas

When the meetings were canceled in Malvinas there wasn't anything we could do about it. After missing a couple of meetings we decided to visit the closest park to their home. Sunday we sent out a message to the whole group letting them know that we missed them and would be at the park that evening if anyone wanted to come visit with us. While no one else showed up at the park, we were able to get some much needed communication started. Please pray as we try to resolve the problems in Malvinas Argentinas.
